Background

The purpose of this workshop is for the California Energy Commission to vet the information and the data received through the "Invitation to Participate" with interested parties. Staff will present an overview of the information received for set top boxes, low power modes and power factor, solar inverters, and general service lamps and will seek input in evaluating the merits and appropriate usage of the information.

The information received through the "Invitation to Participate" should form the basis for Appliance Efficiency Standards and Roadmap proposals. The "Request for Proposals" stage in the Pre-Rulemaking process will occur at a later date.

On March 14, 2012, the Energy Commission issued an Order Instituting Rulemaking (OIR) to formally begin the process of considering standards, test procedures, labeling requirements, and other efficiency measures for the appliances in a three-phase effort. On May 11, 2017, the Energy Commission released an "Invitation to Participate" for Phase 2 which identified the following products and technologies for Appliance Efficiency Standards and Roadmaps:

<u>Appliance Efficiency Standards:</u>

- Commercial and Industrial Fans and Blowers
- General Service Lamps (Expanded Scope)
- Sprinkler Spray Bodies
- Tub-Spout Diverters
- Irrigation Controllers

<u>Appliance Efficiency Roadmaps:</u>

- Set-Top Boxes
- Low-Power Modes and Power Factor
- Solar Inverters

The Energy Commission may use the information submitted during the "Invitation to Participate" to guide decisions regarding Appliance Efficiency Standards and Roadmaps for these topics. At this time, the Energy Commission is not requesting proposals for Appliance Standards or Roadmaps. Interested parties will have the opportunity to submit proposals during the "Request for Proposals" part of the Pre-Rulemaking process.

Any measures resulting from the March 14, 2012, OIR will be incorporated into California's Appliance Efficiency Standards in Title 20 of the California Code of Regulations, §§1601 – 1609, or into staff-issued white papers that will establish non-regulatory efficiency roadmaps for the identified appliance types.
