Dear Mr. Oglesby:

Constellation NewEnergy, Inc., (“CNE”) respectfully requests protection of certain information provided to the Commission in its accompanying Revised Electricity Resource / Supply Plan submission.

Information submitted to the Energy Commission can be deemed confidential without the need for a new application under California Code of Regulations, Title 20, Sections 2505(a)(1)(G) and 2505(a)(4) if CNE files a certification under penalty of perjury that the new information is substantially similar to the information previously granted confidentiality. By letter dated June 5, 2015 (see Attachment A hereto) you approved CNE’s request for confidential designation for information submitted in CNE’s 2015 IEPR Electricity Resource Plan Forms submission in docket 15-IEPR-02. In that letter, you encouraged CNE to take advantage of the repeated application process in the future where appropriate.

CNE’s Revised 2017 Electricity Resource / Supply Plans submission contains information that is substantially similar to its previously submitted 2015 Electricity Resource / Supply Plans submission and all facts and circumstances relevant to the confidentiality of today’s submission’s information remain unchanged.

The California Energy Commission is in receipt of an Application for Confidentiality dated April 24, 2015, submitted by Ellison, Schneider & Harris, LLP for Constellation NewEnergy, Inc. (Applicant), seeking confidential designation for the following information:
