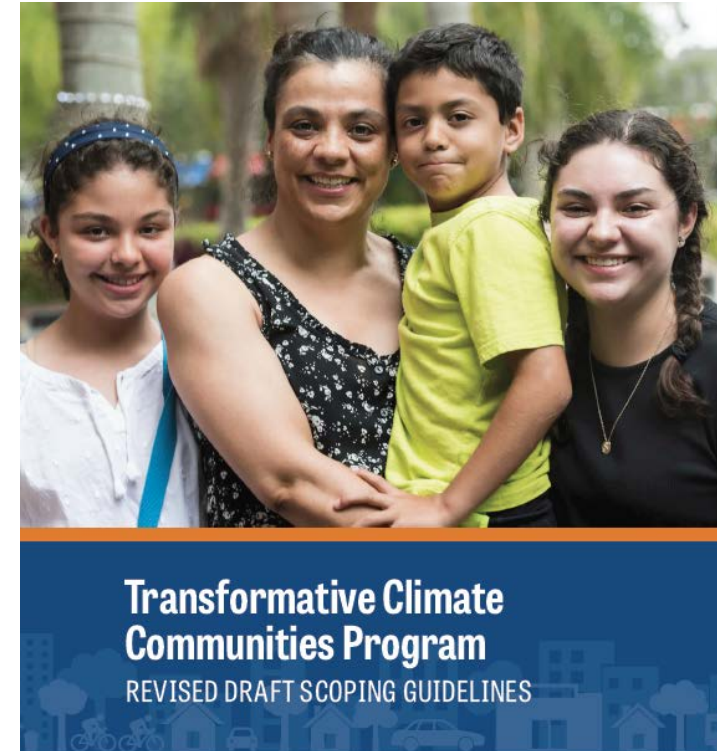

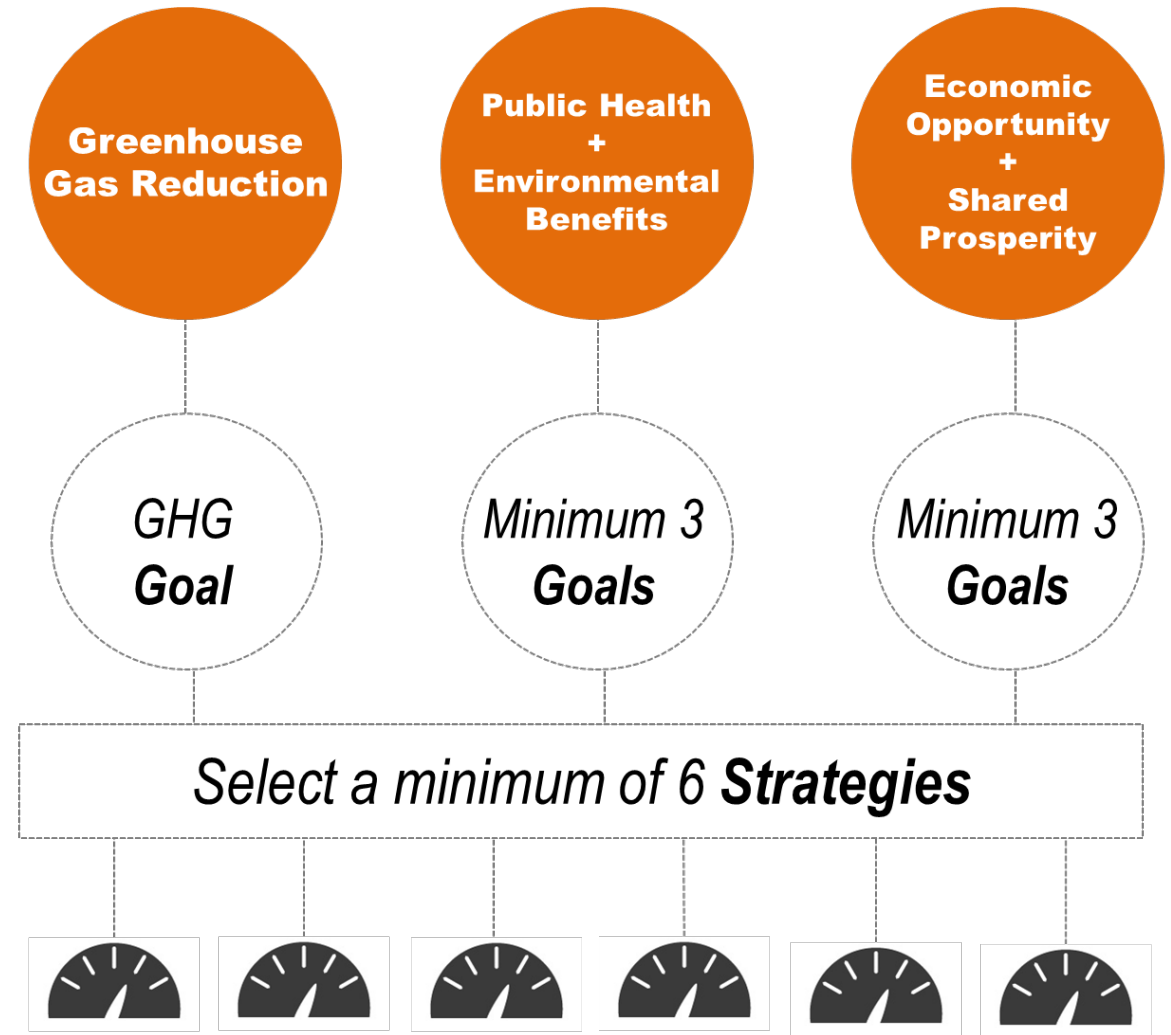

3 OBJECTIVES + REQUIRED GOALS

1. **Achieve Significant Reductions in Greenhouse Gas Emissions.**

Establish a greenhouse gas reduction Goal for the Project Area that meets or exceeds a path toward long-term emissions reductions aligned with State goals.

2. **Improve Public Health and Environmental Benefits.**

Establish a minimum of three Goals to improve public health outcomes for community residents and achieve environmental benefits for the Project Area.

3. **Expand Economic Opportunity and Shared Prosperity.**

Establish a minimum of three Goals for workforce training, employment and local business expansion for the Project Area.



12 STRATEGIES: SELECT MINIMUM OF 6

1. Equitable Land Development
2. Transit Access and Mobility
3. Urban Greening and Green Infrastructure
4. Decarbonized Energy and Energy Efficiency
5. Water Efficiency
6. Robust Food Systems
7. Land Preservation and Restoration
8. Materials Management
9. Climate Resiliency
10. Health and Well-being
11. Workforce Development and Education
12. High Quality Job Creation and Local Economic Development



INDICATORS

- Must Identify Indicators for each Strategy
- Measure and track progress toward the Goals
- Must establish a baseline measurement for the Project Area using the best available data



ELIGIBLE PROJECT TYPES

- Supported by existing California Climate Investment (CCI) Programs
- Project Types and components that do not achieve GHG reductions must use leveraged funding

4 THRESHOLDS

1. Prevent the displacement of existing residents and businesses
2. Ensure community engagement
3. Leverage Funding

APPLICANT ELIGIBILITY

- Eligible applicants
- Multi-stakeholder partnerships
- Consistency with existing plans
- Demonstrate capacity to implement plan



IMPLEMENTATION GRANTS

- 1) Concept Phase
- 2) Full Application



PLANNING GRANTS

- Funding to help communities develop local plans, policies, partnerships or other efforts aligned with TCC Program
- Eligible Applicants:
 - Cities, Counties, MPO, JPA, Regional Transportation Agencies, Council of Government or combinations



TECHNICAL ASSISTANCE & SUPPORT

- Build capacity of communities to apply
- SGC will offer TA to applicants throughout application process
