RE: Training and re-certification of Acceptance Test Technicians and Acceptance Test Employers in regards to the 2016 Building Energy Efficiency Standards

Dear Mr. Bernett:

In a recent conversation with Lea Haro (May 22, 2017), Gary Andis of NEMIC mentioned that the National Energy Management Institute Committee (NEMIC) was training and recertifying Acceptance Test Technicians (ATTs) and Acceptance Test Employers (ATEs) on the 2016 Building Energy Efficiency Standards (Standards). Mr. Andis indicated that NEMIC believed that a letter from Randy Brumley¹ gave NEMIC the necessary approval to begin training and re-certifying ATTs and ATEs for the 2016 Standards.

The letter from Mr. Brumley states that the Energy Commission *staff* finds that the changes to NEMIC's training curricula satisfy all requirements in the 2016 Standards, but that NEMIC's Update Report is incomplete. The Energy Commission must formally approve NEMIC's Update Report prior to NEMIC providing any training under the 2016 standards. To date, NEMIC has not been approved to train or re-certify ATTs or ATEs under the 2016 Standards.
