Dear Mr. Heiser,

In a letter docketed at the California Energy Commission (CEC) by Mr. Dan Phu, Manager of Environmental Programs for the Orange County Transportation Authority (OCTA), Mr. Phu identified an existing bicycle network within the vicinity of the Stanton Energy Reliability Center (SERC). Mr. Phu additionally recommends that measures be employed to reduce potential disruptions to bicycle facilities.

The City would like to clarify that while there are planned bike lanes for Dale Avenue in OCTA's Commuter Bikeways Strategic Plan, no such facilities currently exist. In the future, the City of Stanton would need to allocate funds to initiate for the bike lanes prior to any installation. The City of Stanton does not foresee allocating such funds prior to the completion of construction of the SERC and therefore, does not believe any measures need be incorporated into the SERC License related to the future bike lanes on Dale Avenue.
