Section 368 Corridors: Background

Established under the 2005 Energy Policy Act:

- ✓ *Energy Corridors in 11 western states*
- ✓ *BLM: 5,000 Miles / 92 Land Use Plan Amendments*
- ✓ *USFS: 990 Miles / 38 Land Use Plan Amendments*
- ✓ *131 Corridors are the preferred, but not mandated, locations for future projects*
- ✓ *2012 Settlement Agreement to 'periodically review corridors on regional basis'*
