This is the Energy Commission's 4 Efficiency Committee public hearing on docket 07-5 6 AAER-2, which concerns the repeal of regulations 7 for digital television adapters. I'm Jackie Pfannenstiel; I am the 8 9 Presiding Commissioner of the Efficiency 10 Committee. On the phone is Commissioner Rosenfeld, the Associate Member of the Committee. 11 Are you there, Art? 12 ASSOCIATE MEMBER ROSENFELD: 13 I am here. 14 PRESIDING MEMBER PFANNENSTIEL: Thank 15 you. This should be a fairly straightforward 16 17 proceeding. The Energy Commission adopted standards for various appliances, including 18 television, digital television adapters, to take 19 20 effect on January 1, 2008. We have since then learned that the 21 National Telecommunications Infrastructure 22 Administration has adopted standards for DTAs that 23 24 we believe will, in fact, provide further energy 25 savings to the State of California.

Therefore, we are hereby proposing to 1 2 repeal the standards that we had previously adopted for DTAs. з With that I'll ask the staff, the staff 4 counsel in this matter, to provide some background 5 of the issue. Bill. 6 MR. STAAK: Good morning, Commissioners. 7 My name is Bill Staak; I'm a Senior Staff Counsel 8 for the Energy Commission. I also have with me 9 today, Ms. Chrisman and Mr. Singh of our technical 10 staff of the appliance efficiency program. 11 We are here today to accept public 12 comments for the notice of proposed action, docket 13 14 number 07-AAER-2, which consists of amendments to the appliance regulations in Title 20, California 15 Code of Regulations, to repeal the appliance 16 17 efficiency standard for digital television 18 adapters. The Energy Commission published the 19 20 notice of proposed action that includes the 21 initial statement of reasons with supporting 22 documentation and express terms; which provides 23 that the Energy Commission's legal and technical basis for the proposed repeal of the DTA 24 25 efficiency standards.

The public comment period for these 1 2 proposed regulations began on August 24, 2007; and will end on October 10, 2007. з On October 10, 2007, the full Energy 4 Commission will consider adopting these proposed 5 6 amendments at a public hearing. 7 Finally, any person may present oral statements or arguments relevant to this proposed 8 9 action at today's hearing; and submit written comments up to 10:00 a.m. on October 10, 2007, the 10 date the full Energy Commission will consider 11 adoption of the proposed regulations. 12 Unless you have any questions this would 13 be the end of my presentation. 14 PRESIDING MEMBER PFANNENSTIEL: 15 Thank 16 you, Mr. Staak. 17 I would ask now whether there's anybody 18 in the public who would like to make comments. 19 Mr. Jensen. 20 MR. JENSEN: Madam Chair and Member, Kelly Jensen representing the Consumer Electronics 21 22 Association. We thank the Commission very much 23 for their proposed action today, and to send this on to the full Commission. 24 It was our pleasure working with you to try and resolve this issue. 25
