Staff's Prehearing Conference Statement (ISO Hearing)

On August 25, 2017, the Puente Power Project Application for Certification Committee (Committee) filed a "Notice of Evidentiary Hearing and Committee Conferences, Order for Prehearing Filing of Evidentiary Objections and Motions, and Related Orders." In the Notice, the Committee set the date for the Prehearing Conference as September 12, 2017, and ordered each party planning to participate in the Prehearing Conference to file a Prehearing Conference Statement.

1. The issues in dispute that require adjudication and the precise nature of the dispute for each issue. Issues are limited to those related to the California ISO Study.

While Staff considers cost and feasibility the two main issues raised by the California ISO's study, Staff has no testimony to offer except to point out that these are issues best resolved through the California Public Utilities Commission's (CPUC) procurement process.

2. The identity of each witness the party intends to sponsor at the Evidentiary Hearing, the subject area(s) about which the witness(es) will offer testimony, whether the testimony will be oral or in writing, a brief summary of the testimony to be offered by the witness(es), qualifications of each witness, the time required to present testimony by each witness, and whether the witness seeks to testify telephonically.

Mark Hesters, Senior Electrical Engineer, in the Strategic Transmission Planning and Corridor Designation Office of the Siting, Transmission, and Environmental Protection Division, will appear on the panel representing Energy Commission Staff. Mr. Hesters

has not filed written testimony, but will be available to answer questions posed by the Committee and ask questions of other panel members.

3. Subject areas upon which the party desires to question the other parties' and the California ISO's witness(es), a summary of the scope of the questions (including questions regarding witness qualifications), the issue(s) to which the questions pertain, and the time desired to question each witness. (Note: A party who fails to specify the scope, relevance and time for questioning other parties' witness(es) risks preclusion from questioning witnesses on that subject area.)

At this time, Staff does not plan to question the other parties' witnesses, however, Staff requests the Committee reserve 30 minutes to either allow for Staff comment or questions.
