Dear Mr. Oglesby:

Pursuant to Title 20, Ca. Code Regs, §2505 (a) (4), AMD (the applicant) is seeking a confidential designation for business confidential information that is substantially similar to information that was previously deemed confidential by the Executive Director pursuant to subdivision (a) (3) (A) §2505.

On June 2, 2015, AMD filed an Application requesting that "....information contained in an attached Power Point presentation comprised of AMD proprietary technical data and designs, AMD confidential non-public future product roadmaps, AMD recommendations for discrete graphics adders based on future product roadmaps and offerings...." be designated as confidential and exempt from disclosure, under the Ca. Public Records Act, pursuant to Ca, Government Code §§ 6254 (k) (trade secrets) (collectively the "Original Application"). In response to that application, the Energy Commission, on June 8, 2015, granted AMD's request for confidential designation for a period of ten years.

On March 27, 2017, AMD filed an Addendum to the Original Application and submitted additional confidential non-public trade secret information that was substantially similar to the information submitted with the Original Application. In response to the Addendum, the Energy Commission, on April 7, 2017, granted AMD's request for confidential designation.

At a meeting with CEC staff on June 2, 2017, a request was made by CEC staff for additional information. The information in the Power Point presentation which is submitted with this Repeated Application, is in response to that request. It is designated as confidential, and it contains AMD confidential trade secret information which is substantially similar to the information previously submitted with the Original Application and Addendum. It includes material, non-public information, the public disclosure of which would be competitively injurious to AMD's position in the technology marketplace.

I have been authorized to make this application and certification on behalf of AMD. With my signature to this letter I certify under penalty of perjury that the information submitted is substantially similar to the previously submitted information, and that all the facts and circumstances relevant to confidentiality remain unchanged.



I respectfully request that the Energy Commission extend the original grant of confidentiality to the information submitted with this application.
