DONALD VON RAESFELD POWER PLANT- REPLACE TURBINE WITH
IDENTICAL TURBINE AMENDMENT
(02-AFC-3C)**

On August 15, 2017, Silicon Valley Power (SVP), a division of the city of Santa Clara, filed a petition with the California Energy Commission (Energy Commission) to modify the Donald Von Raesfeld Power Plant (DVR)(02-AFC-03C). This Petition requests approval to use an identical spare natural gas-fired combustion turbine while maintenance activities are performed on either of the existing natural gas combustion turbines for the DVR. The DVR is a 122-megawatt (MW), natural gas-fired, combined-cycle electrical generating plant. The DVR is located on approximately 2.86 acres at 850 Duane Avenue in the city of Santa Clara, in Santa Clara County, California.

DESCRIPTION OF PROPOSED MODIFICATIONS

SVP seeks to modify the California Energy Commission Final Decision to specifically allow for a like-kind exchange turbine at DVR that can be used as a substitute for any one of the existing two turbines that needs maintenance.

ENERGY COMMISSION AMENDMENT REVIEW PROCEDURES

Energy Commission staff is reviewing the petition to assess the impacts of this proposal on environmental quality and public health and safety. The review process includes an evaluation of the consistency of the proposed changes with the Energy Commission's Decision and a determination whether the facility, as modified, would remain in compliance with applicable laws, ordinances, regulations and standards (20 Cal. Code of Regs., § 1769). After the staff has completed its independent review and analysis of this petition, it will publish an assessment for public review and comment. Upon completion of its review, staff will provide written notice of its intent to either process the proposed changes as a Staff Approved Project Modification or schedule it for consideration by the Energy Commission at a regularly scheduled Business Meeting.

This notice of receipt has been mailed to the Commission's DVR mail list of interested parties and property owners adjacent to the facility site. It has also been emailed to the DVR listserv. The listserv is an automated Energy Commission email system by which information about this facility is e-mailed to parties who have subscribed. To subscribe, go to the Commission's webpage for this facility, cited above, scroll down the right side of the project's webpage to the box labeled "Subscribe," and provide the requested contact information.
