The California Energy Commission adopted the *New Solar Homes Partnership Guidebook, Eleventh Edition (NSHP Guidebook)* at its October 11, 2017, Business Meeting. This update includes changes to address deadlines to submit reservation and payment claim applications in order to satisfy Public Utilities Code § 2851(e)(3)(B), changes to incentive levels and calculations, improvements to increase participation from affordable housing projects, program streamlining efforts, and input received from stakeholders on program improvements.

The *NSHP Guidebook* describes the requirements for participating in the New Solar Homes Partnership and receiving incentives for installing eligible solar energy systems on new residential construction located in specified investor-owned utility territories. The effective date of the *NSHP Guidebook, Eleventh Edition*, is October 11, 2017.
