Subject: Damper box insulation ratings for whole house fans used for Title 24, Part 6 compliance.

## Issue:

In 2013 we had a measure 4.507.1 that required whole house fans, when installed, to have a minimum of R-4.2 on the damper system. This was repealed in 2013 code for CalGree Title 24, part 11.

IHere is the official notice:

REPEALED: Section 4.507.1 Openings (for whole house fans) has been repealed. There is no substitute language.

## **Comments:**

Having uninsulated dampers is a weakness in the thermal envelope, and we are uncertain why this measure was removed from CalGreen. We are surmising that since CalGreen focuses more on sustainable design, this energy related requirement was repealed from Part 11.

## **Proposed Solution:**

We are requesting the staff at the CA Enegy commission please consider adding this requirement to sections 150.1.12(c).12 as a subitem D. Here is some example language that can be used:

- C. Append "; and" to the end of subitem C.
- D. Whole house fans installed for compliance must have a minimum of R4.2 on the damper system.
