TO ALL PARTIES IN A.13-12-012 and I.14-06-016:

PLEASE TAKE NOTICE THAT on November 17, 2017, Pacific Gas and Electric Company (PG&E) filed “Application of PG&E Proposing Cost of Service and Rates for Gas Transmission and Storage Services for the Period 2019-2021.”

The Application requests that the California Public Utilities Commission (Commission or “CPUC”) increase PG&E’s gas transmission and storage rates, effective January 1, 2019, to collect the revenue requirements necessary for PG&E to continue to provide safe and reliable service to its customers.

Pursuant to Rule 1.9(d) of the Commission’s Rules of Practice and Procedure, PG&E is issuing this Notice of Availability (NOA). The NOA is being served on all parties listed on the official service lists for A.13-12-012 and I.14-06-016 which are attached to the certificate of service for this document.
