Quick Guide to NSHP Eligibility Requirements

Important Deadlines

All reservation applications must be received by April 1, 2018

All payment claims must be received by August 31, 2021

Before applying to NSHP, you should be able to answer yes to the following:

- Is your home considered new construction or a full remodel?
- Are you receiving electric service from PG&E, SDG&E, BVES, or SCE?
- Are your solar arrays within the azimuths of 90 and 280 degrees?
- Has a solar permit been applied for prior to occupancy of your home?
- Is the PV system new and covered by a minimum 10-year warranty?

Things to consider if applying for NSHP incentives:

- ❖ Submit your application to NSHP prior to the April 1, 2018, deadline to ensure your application is processed.
- ❖ If your new home has completed construction and solar has been installed, you must apply to NSHP within six months of interconnection.
- ❖ Arrange with a PV HERS rater to have your PV system verified once it is installed.
