## **Gas Moratorium**

Hello,

I am a general contractor working on a large commercial project in Los Angeles. I received the notice below.

On Friday December 15,2017, the California Public Utilities Commission (CPUC) released a draft resolution ordering SoCalGas to implement a moratorium on new natural gas service connections for commercial and industrial customers in all of Los Angeles County (incorporated and unincorporated alike). The moratorium would last until 3/31/18.

This moratorium has the potential to cost Thermo Fisher millions of dollars who needs gas service between now and 3/31/18. We have been trying to obtain gas service since 5/22/17, what are our options moving forward?
