STANTON ENERGY RELIABILITY CENTER, LLC's STATUS REPORT No. 9

In accordance with the Committee Scheduling Order dated May 1, 2017, Stanton Energy Reliability Center, LLC (SERC, LLC) has prepared this Status Report No. 9 to inform the Committee of the progress made in the review of the Application For Certification (AFC) for the Stanton Energy Reliability Center (SERC). The following summarizes the status of the Commission process since the filing of Status Report No. 8 on December 15, 2017.

## **SCAQMD**

The most recent update SERC, LLC received from the South Coast Air Quality Management (SCAQMD) regarding the publication of the Preliminary Determination of Compliance (PDOC) led SERC, LLC to believe that the PDOC would be released by January 12, 2017. We understand that the PDOC is in final management review and should be released within days.

## Supplemental Response to Data Request

SERC, LLC filed a supplemental response to Data Request A10 relating to the positive effect the SERC, LLC would have on air emissions within the basin. The response is based on a study performed by ZGlobal that predicts changes to dispatch of other gasfired units within the South Coast Air Basin as a result of dispatch of SERC's Hybrid EGT®s. The net result is that dispatch of the SERC, primarily for emission-free spinning-

reserve, will avoid emissions from other facilities in amounts that exceed the proposed potential for emissions from the SERC.
