Dear Ms. Berenstein,

This correspondence refers to the December 19, 2017 Application for Confidential Designation (“Application”) sent on behalf of Pilot Automotive, Inc. (“Pilot”) with respect to purported violations of the CEC’s energy efficiency requirements. Pilot wishes to withdraw the Application (TN # 222026) and instead make this submittal as a confidential settlement communication in further response to the CEC’s request for further information from the November 16, 2017 submission from Pilot. As reflected in this cover letter, Pilot is applying for confidential treatment for this submittal. This submittal contains this cover letter along with 24 pages of a laboratory test report and data results.

This letter is submitted in compliance with the Repeated Application process in California Code of Regulations, Title 20, section 2505(a)(4). This provision states that an applicant seeking confidential designation for information that is substantially similar to information previously deemed confidential by the Commission need not reapply, but can provide “a certification, executed under penalty of perjury, stating that the information submitted is substantially similar to the previously submitted information and that all the facts and circumstances relevant to confidentiality remain unchanged.”

Prior settlement communications from Pilot were previously granted a confidential designation by the Executive Director pursuant to subdivision (a)(3)(A) of this section. The information here also is a settlement communication, and is “substantially similar” to the prior submittal, in that it contains references to materials previously submitted and designated confidential.
