Background

The Energy Commission proposes to modify existing appliance efficiency regulations for portable electric spas to clarify the scope, update the performance standard, update the test procedure, and add a labeling requirement. The proposed regulations also modify the battery charger marking requirements to require a "BC" mark only for state-regulated battery chargers. On January 29, 2018, the Energy Commission released the Notice of Proposed Action (NOPA), Initial Statement of Reasons (ISOR), and proposed

regulatory language for portable electric spas and battery chargers. The final staff report for portable electric spas was also published on February 2, 2018. As part of the formal rulemaking procedure, the Energy Commission is hosting a public meeting to present the proposed regulations to the public and to seek comments from interested parties.
