EVBox believes that adding the Energy Star Requirement is a step forward to further commercialize EV charging in California. However, it has proven difficult for many EVSE manufacturers to get Energy Star Certified. This is not due to stringent testing, but because of a lack of interest at the certified testing laboratories to do the test. We have addressed this with the Energy Star office at the DOE

EVBox proposes a grace period of 3-6 months for the Energy Star requirement, this should give EVSE manufacturers enough time to get the testing done, while simultaneously pushing the industry further.
