History of Pre-Rulemaking

- March 14, 2012: Energy Commission issued an Order Instituting Rulemaking
- March 25, 2013: Energy Commission released an invitation to participate (ITP) to collect data on potential efficiency standards
- May 28-31, 2013: Energy Commission hosted public workshops on ITP
- June 13, 2013: Energy Commission released an invitation to submit proposals
- May 28, 2014: Energy Commission requested additional information on network equipment, commercial clothes dryers, portable electric spas, and pool pumps and motors



History of Pre-Rulemaking (Cont.)

- January 28, 2016: Energy Commission published a draft staff report proposing standards for portable electric spas
- February 18, 2016: Energy Commission held first staff workshop
- June 16, 2016: Energy Commission published a revised staff report proposing standards for portable electric spas
- July 13, 2016: Energy Commission held second staff workshop
- July 12, 2017: Energy Commission published a second revised staff report proposing standards for portable electric spas
- August 3, 2017: Energy Commission held third staff workshop




History of Formal Rulemaking

- January 29, 2018: Energy Commission released NOPA, ISOR, and Proposed Regulatory Language for portable electric spas and battery charger systems
- **February 2, 2018**: California Regulatory Notice Register published NOPA for portable electric spas and battery charger systems
- **February 2, 2018**: Energy Commission published final staff report for portable electric spas
- **February 8, 2018**: Energy Commission released Initial Study and Negative Declaration for portable electric spas and battery chargers
