



Statewide Percent of Average for Date: 38%





# Regulation overview

## Section 963(b)(1)

- (A) Don't allow runoff
- (B) Don't wash vehicles without shutoff nozzle attached to hose
- (C) Don't water driveways and sidewalks
- (D) Don't use potable water in fountains, unless...
- (E) Don't irrigate in the rain
- (F) Don't serve drinking water, unless a customer asks
- (G) Don't irrigate turf on medians and 'parkways,' unless...

## Section 963(c)

- Hotels and motels: Give guests the option of laundering linens

## Section 963(d) and (e)

- (d) HOAs: Don't violate existing law
- (e) Cities and counties: Don't violate existing law

Don't apply water to outdoor landscapes in a manner that causes more than incidental runoff such that water flows onto adjacent property, non-irrigated areas, private and public walkways, roadways, parking lots, or structures.
