Hi Jen,

Our cultural resources team completed the NWIC records search for McLaren. The results are summarized below and attached is a spreadsheet with the results as well.

Results summary:

- No archaeological resources have been recorded in the project site or within 0.25 mile of the project site. See below for additional information about archaeological resources located farther away from the site.
- One built resource is located approximately 0.25 mile north of the project site. This resource is recommended as ineligible for listing to the National Register of Historic Places (NRHP).
- No cultural resources studies have been conducted within the project site, but two studies cover areas adjacent to the project area:
 - 35004. M. Homan and Alexander, I. 2008. *A Report of Findings from Mechanical Subsurface Archaeological Testing of the Santa Clara 535 Reed Street Project Area, Santa Clara, Santa Clara County, California; and*
 - 22948. M.P. Holman. 2000. *Archaeological Backhoe Trenching of the Exodus Property, Santa Clara, Santa Clara County, California (letter report).*
 - Please note that both reports document presence/absence subsurface testing and report negative findings.
- The two buildings within the project site are age-eligible and were recorded and evaluated on DPR 523 forms by ICF as part of the McLaren Data Center IS/MND in 2017.

Additional information about archaeological resources: While the records search did not identify any archaeological resources within the project site (as discussed above), 2 large multi-component sites are located within 0.5-mile (east and southeast) of the project site. These resources are both associated with the Mission Santa Clara de Asis. De Asis has been the subject of archaeological investigations for almost 90 years and is recommended as eligible for listing to the NRHP. Subsurface deposits have been uncovered as late as 2010. Both studies described above were conducted between these resources and the McLaren project site and failed to indicate the presence of subsurface archaeological material. However, the proximity of the project site to these resources may indicate increased sensitivity.
