Background

Pursuant to the establishment of the Senate Bill 350 (de León, Chapter 547, Statutes of 2015) Disadvantaged Communities Advisory Group and the appointment of the Advisory Group nominees by the California Public Utilities Commission (CPUC) and the California Energy Commission (Energy Commission), the CPUC and the Energy Commission will jointly convene the first meeting of the Disadvantaged Communities Advisory Group.
