Staff Report on the Refrigeration Service Engineers Society's application to be approved as an Acceptance Test Technician Certification Provider for Nonresidential Mechanical Systems

CEC-400-2018-010

The *2016 Building Energy Efficiency Standards* (2016 Energy Standards), section 10-103.2(c) requires that potential acceptance test technician certification providers (ATTCPs) for nonresidential mechanical systems submit a written application to the California Energy Commission for review and approval.

Energy Commission staff has evaluated the Refrigeration Service Engineers Society's (RSES) application to be approved as an ATTCP for nonresidential mechanical systems. Staff's evaluation was completed in accordance with the application review and determination process outlined in section 103.2(e) of the 2016 Energy Standards.

Section 10-103.2(e) of the 2016 Energy Standards requires the Energy Commission to give all interested persons a copy of staff's evaluation and provide an opportunity for public comment. As such, the Energy Commission is posting the staff report detailing the review and evaluation of RSES's application.

Oral comments will be accepted during the regularly scheduled business meeting on May 9, 2018, when the Energy Commission will consider approving RSES's application to be approved as an ATTCP for nonresidential mechanical systems. Written comments should be submitted to the Dockets Unit by **5:00 p.m. on May 2, 2018**. Written comments will also be accepted up to and during the aforementioned business meeting; however, the Energy Commission may not have time to review them before the conclusion of the meeting.
