King City Energy Center (01-EP-06C) Gilroy Energy Center, LLC (the "Project Owner")

Cultural Resources Data Recovery Investigation Buried Hearth KC-01-01.

2. State the length of time the record should be kept confidential, and provide justification for the length of time.
