**RESOLUTION APPROVING THE REFRIGERATION SERVICE ENGINEERS
SOCIETY AS A NONRESIDENTIAL MECHANICAL ACCEPTANCE
TEST TECHNICIAN CERTIFICATION PROVIDER**

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 10-103.2(c) of the *2016 Building Energy Efficiency Standards* (2016 Energy Standards), codified in the California Code of Regulations, Title 24, Part 1, Chapter 10, the Refrigeration Service Engineers Society (RSES) submitted an application to the California Energy Commission to become a Nonresidential Mechanical Acceptance Test Technician Certification Provider (ATTCP); and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 10-103.2(e) of the 2016 Energy Standards, Energy Commission staff reviewed RSES's application according to the criteria and procedures in Section 10-103.2(c) of the 2016 Energy Standards and recommended that the Energy Commission approve RSES as an ATTCP subject to one condition of approval; and

WHEREAS, RSES proposes to meet the quality assurance requirements of Section 10-103.2(c)3F of the proposed 2019 Energy Standards, that these requirements are equally as stringent as the requirements of the 2016 Energy Standards, and that these requirements resolve logistical issues raised by the 2016 Energy Standards; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 10-103.2(e) of the 2016 Energy Standards, the executive director of the Energy Commission provided a written recommendation, attached as "Exhibit A," describing the review and validation of RSES's application by Energy Commission staff and recommending approval of RSES as an ATTCP subject to one condition of approval; and

WHEREAS, the Energy Commission has considered the executive director's written recommendation, all written comments submitted, oral comments made at today's business meeting, and any Energy Commission staff responses to comments on this matter.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Energy Commission confirms the executive director's findings, adopts his recommendation, and approves RSES as an ATTCP to administer the program described in its application subject to the condition of approval in Appendix 1 of the executive director's recommendation; and

THEREFORE BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that demonstrating compliance with the quality assurance requirements of Section 10-103.2(c)3F of the proposed 2019 Energy Standards is sufficient to demonstrate compliance with Section 10-103.2(c)3F of the 2016 Energy Standards; and

THEREFORE BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Energy Commission finds that RSES's application meets the requirements in Section 10-103.2(c) of the 2016 Energy Standards; and

THEREFORE BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Energy Commission may review RSES's compliance with the procedures required by Section 10-103.2 of the 2016 Energy Standards and the condition of approval in Appendix 1 of the executive director's recommendation. Pursuant to Section 10-103.2(g) of the 2016 Energy Standards, if the Energy Commission determines that there is a violation of the 2016 Energy Standards, including noncompliance with the condition of approval in Appendix 1 of the Executive Director's recommendation, or that RSES is no longer providing adequate training, testing, and certification services, the Energy Commission may revoke the authorization of RSES pursuant to Section 1230 et. seq. of Title 20 of the California Code of Regulations.
