
**Project Description:** The Victorville 2 Hybrid Power Project was certified by the Energy Commission on July 16, 2008 as a 563-megawatt (MW) hybrid facility consisting of up to 50 MW generated through solar trough technology. The project was never constructed.

**Modification Description:** The City of Victorville has requested that the license for the Victorville 2 Hybrid Power Project, Docket 07-AFC-1C, be terminated effective June 30, 2018.

On May 9, 2018, the California Energy Commission approved the above-described project change pursuant to a regulatory program certified by the California Secretary of Resources under section 21080.5 of the California Public Resources Code, finding that:

1. The project will not have a significant effect on the environment;
2. Mitigation measures were made a condition of approval of the project;
3. The project is in compliance with all laws, ordinances, regulations, and standards; and
4. A statement of Overriding Considerations was not adopted for the project.
