# Assembly Bill 802 (2015)

1. Requires energy utilities to provide building-level energy use data upon request.
2. Directed the Energy Commission to create a benchmarking and public disclosure program.



# Regulatory Definitions

## **Covered Building (Data Access):**

1. No residential utility accounts, or
2. Five or more active utility accounts, at least one of which is residential



# Regulatory Definitions

**Disclosable Building (Benchmarking and Public Disclosure) – Larger than 50,000 square feet and:**

1. No active residential utility accounts, or
2. 17 or more active residential utility accounts of each energy type serving the building



# Regulatory Schedule

<b>Disclosable Building Type</b>	<b>First Reporting Deadline</b>	<b>First Building-Level Public Disclosure</b>
No residential utility accounts	June 1, 2018 (2017 data)	2019 (2018 data)
17+ residential utility accounts	June 1, 2019 (2018 data)	2020 (2019 data)
