**STAFF RESPONSE TO COMMITTEE ORDER  
REGARDING ADDITIONAL EVIDENCE**

California Energy Commission Staff (Staff) hereby responds to the Committee's May 29, 2018 order, *Denial of Staff Motion to Bifurcate* (Order). The Order directs Staff to notify the Committee on or before June 15, 2018 if Staff plans to present additional evidence relevant to the specific factual claims of the Stockton Port District (Port), and if so, directs Staff to file such additional evidence by declaration on or before June 22, 2018.<sup>1</sup>

Although Staff is still reviewing the documents submitted by the Port on June 12, 2018, and comparing them to information and documents previously provided to Staff by the Port, Staff at this time does not anticipate filings any additional evidence. However, if Staff discovers inconsistencies between the documents submitted by the Port on June 12, 2018, and the information and documents previously provided to Staff, and Staff has additional evidence to address these inconsistencies, Staff reserves the right to file such additional evidence on or before June 22, 2018.

Additionally, Staff intends to file comments on or before June 22, 2018, or at such later date as may be directed or permitted by the Committee, disputing the Port's position that "its actions constitute full compliance or substantial compliance with the adoption requirements of the relevant statutory and regulatory provisions" for optional compliance measures.<sup>2</sup>
