

Additionally, staff would like to correct an incorrect reference in Table 1 on page 4.5-3 in the Hazardous Materials Management section of the Final Staff Assessment (FSA). Row 4 incorrectly references non-existent Condition of Certification HAZ-10 as a basis for finding compliance with Title 49, Code of Federal Regulations, part 190. This row should instead read as follows:
