Senate Bill 1414 Overview

(Wolk, Chapter 678, Statutes of 2016)

- Requires Energy Commission to:
 - Approve plan promoting compliance of central air conditioning and heat pump installations
 - Consult with CSLB, local building officials
 - Consider property owners, local governments, HVAC contractors, distributors, manufacturers
 - Ensure data collection, use is feasible, affordable
 - Allow public to review, comment on proposed plan
- Gives Energy Commission the authority to adopt regulations consistent with the plan
