**Project Location:** AEC is located at on the site of the Alamitos Generating Station (AGS), an existing and operating power plant located at 690 North Studebaker Road in the City of Long Beach, California.

**Project Description:** The amendment proposed by this petition is the temporary use of an additional construction materials and equipment laydown and parking area.

**Modification Description:** The project owner proposes to utilize approximately 2 acres of graveled parcel located adjacent to the AEC/AGS project site that is located on Southern California Edison (SCE) property. The proposed additional temporary construction material, equipment laydown and parking area is used for maintenance and construction laydown area for the SCE onsite switchyard.

On August 3, 2018, the California Energy Commission staff approved the above-described project change pursuant to a regulatory program certified by the California Secretary of Resources under section 21080.5 of the California Public Resources Code, finding that:

1. The project will not have a significant effect on the environment;
2. No additional mitigation measures were made a condition of approval of the project;
3. The project is in compliance with all laws, ordinances, regulations, and standards; and
4. A statement of Overriding Considerations was not adopted for the project.


