As included in this section, it may be implied that the certification is specifically relevant to inverters only. We ask the Commission to include a footnote that the certification requirement to IEEE 2030.5:2018, in accordance with the *SunSpec Common Smart Inverter Profile (CSIP) Conformance Test* Procedure applies to the generating facility and may be applied to the inverter, EMS or aggregator.
