3	COMMISSIONER SCOTT: Okay, good afternoon
4	everyone and welcome. This is a Committee
5	Conference for the Puente Power Project AFC.
6	I'm Commissioner Janea Scott, the
7	Presiding Member on this case.
8	Two folks over to my right is
9	Commissioner Karen Douglas, who's the Associate
10	Member.
11	On my left are my Advisors, Matt Coldwell
12	and Rhetta deMesa.
13	On Commissioner Douglas's right are her
14	two Advisors, Jenn Nelson and Le-Quyen Nguyen.
15	And to my immediate right is Hearing
16	Officer Paul Kramer.
17	Let us have the parties introduce
18	themselves, starting with the Applicant.
19	MR. CARROLL: Good afternoon. This is Mike
20	Carroll, with Latham & Watkins, on behalf of the
21	Applicant.
22	COMMISSIONER SCOTT: Good afternoon.
23	MR. BEATTY: Sean Beatty, Regional General
24	Counsel for the West Region, for NRG, in the
25	room.

1 COMMISSIONER SCOTT: Good afternoon. 2 HEARING OFFICER KRAMER: Can you make sure 3 you give the court reporter your card? He's got 4 it, okay. 5 COMMISSIONER SCOTT: Okay, let's now turn 6 to the Energy Commission staff to introduce themselves, please. 7 8 MR. PAYNE: Lon Payne, Project Manager, 9 appearing for staff. 10 COMMISSIONER SCOTT: Is your mic on? 11 MR. PAYNE: Sorry. Lon Payne, Project 12 Manager, appearing for staff. 13 We've also got Kerry Willis and Michelle 14 Chester from the Chief Counsel's Office. 15 COMMISSIONER SCOTT: Good afternoon. Do I 16 have any of the Intervenors on the WebEx? There 17 are none sitting in the room. If so, please go 18 ahead and introduce yourselves. 19 Okay. Do we have any others on the line, 20 the California Independent System Operator, the 21 Coastal Commission, U.S. Geological Survey, any 22 State or Federal Wildlife Agencies? If so, please 23 go ahead and introduce yourself. 24 And do we have any officials from local, 25 regional, state, or federal, or tribal who would

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1 like to introduce themselves? If so, please go 2 ahead and say hello.

3 Okay. And I'd also like to make note that
4 we have Alana Mathews and Rosemary Avalos, our
5 Public Advisers, here in the room with us.

6 And with that I will turn this over to7 Hearing Officer Paul Kramer.

8 HEARING OFFICER KRAMER: Okay, thank you. 9 For the Committee Conference portion of our 10 agenda, pending motions, petitions or requests, I 11 will note that we have pending, because it was 12 filed on Monday, the Applicant's request to 13 suspend the proceeding.

We're not planning on discussing that or ruling on that today. Rather the plan is, because our regulations require, unless the Presiding Member changes the schedule, that the other parties have 14 days in which to respond to a motion such as that.

20 So we're planning on scheduling an 21 additional Committee Conference shortly after 22 that period expires. And by our calculations, the 23 last day to file responses would be October 30th. 24 So, we'll confirm it later, but right now 25 I think we're looking at the afternoon of October

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31st to have a Committee Conference where, if
 it's necessary to discuss that motion, that would
 be the time and place, and then the Committee
 would rule some point after that.

5 So then that brings us to the Public 6 Comment portion of the agenda, where members of 7 the public or other interested persons and 8 entities, and that of course would include the 9 parties, may speak up to three minutes on a 10 matter related to this agenda.

11 So do we have anyone? Let's see, we have 12 nobody in the room who is a candidate to make a 13 public comment, unless staff wants to say 14 something.

15 Ms. Willis?

MS. WILLIS: Thank you. Kerry Willis, Assistant Chief Counsel. Just hearing what you were saying about the schedule, staff did not intend to file a response to the motion, but we do not oppose the motion, if that helps.

21 HEARING OFFICER KRAMER: Okay, thank you.
22 We now know that.

Does anybody on the telephone wish to 24 make a comment? You're all unmuted so speak up. 25 First, just say your name so we can put you on

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1 the list.

2 Okay, one more time. Nobody wants to make 3 a public comment. Okay, we will close public 4 comment.

5 And we are going to adjourn to a closed 6 session pursuant to Government Code 11126(c)(3), 7 which allows this Committee to hold a closed 8 session to deliberate on a decision to be reached 9 in a proceeding.

10 Let me find a time to return.

11 (Pause)

HEARING OFFICER KRAMER: Okay, we'll be hear about 2:30, no earlier, even if we finish earlier. If we drag over a little bit, of course we'll be a little late. But at least you have the time between now and then to do whatever you'd like.

18 So we're adjourned, thank you.

19 (Convened Closed Session at 1:40 p.m.)
20 (Reconvened Public Session at 2:54 p.m.)
21 HEARING OFFICER KRAMER: This is Paul
22 Kramer. We're back on the record. We just
23 finished the closed session about 2:52.
24 Nothing to report -- well, one thing to

25 report out that I mentioned earlier is that we're

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1 going to schedule a follow-up Committee 2 Conference on October 31st, beginning at 1:30 p.m., in this same room here, Hearing Room A. 3 4 And among the things that will be on the agenda is a discussion, if it's necessary, about 5 6 the Applicant's motion to suspend the proceeding. 7 Again, the deadline for responses from the parties is October 30. And I just said 8 9 October 31st a minute ago for the new conference, 10 I hope. That's the day. So it's the day after the 11 deadline for responses to the motion. 12 And that will include both, you know, a 13 little bit of public time discussing that again, 14 if we need to, and also the Committee will be 15 continuing its deliberations in closed session. 16 So with that, we have nothing further to 17 report and so we are adjourned. Thank you. 18 (Thereupon, the Hearing was adjourned at 19 2:56 p.m.) 20 ------21 22 23 24 25


