REAP is a competitive grant solicitation, offered as a program of the California Climate Investments and funded by Greenhouse Gas Reduction Fund (GGRF) monies. The REAP provides funds for projects that install on-site renewable energy projects and additional optional equipment on agricultural operations in California. All GGRF-funded projects must provide real and quantifiable greenhouse gas (GHG) emission reductions. Consistent with the requirements of GGRF-funded programs, the award of funds under REAP will prioritize investments in projects that achieve the highest GHG reductions, maximize benefits to priority populations, and contribute to achieving the state's climate goals.
