Background

The Draft Solicitation Concepts document details the concepts under consideration for a solicitation on hydrogen refueling infrastructure to be issued by the Energy Commission's Alternative and Renewable Fuel and Vehicle Technology Program (ARFVTP). The goal of the next solicitation is to provide grant funds to projects to expand California's early commercial hydrogen refueling and FCEV markets, and to accommodate the projected FCEV rollout in the 2021-2024 timeframe. This network of hydrogen refueling stations, hydrogen fuel supply, and FCEVs will support the carbon emissions reduction and air quality improvement goals of the State of California.

No proposals are being accepted at this time. This is a draft compilation of solicitation concepts. Do not design or submit proposals according to this draft. The actual solicitation is subject to change.
