Voluntary Curtailment to Remain through February 12

Good afternoon,

The curtailment of electric generation customers on the SoCalGas system, which had been initiated on February 6 pursuant to Rule 23 and in coordination with the Balancing Authorities, as well as the system-wide Curtailment Watch for SoCalGas and SDG&E also issued on February 6, will both end at 11:59 PM, February 8.

Due to continued low temperatures and expected high customer demand, SoCalGas has issued a system-wide **voluntary** curtailment for electric generation customers effective 12:00 AM February 9 and through 11:59 PM February 12, in accordance with the Aliso Canyon Withdrawal Protocol. The curtailment is a voluntary request coordinated through the Balancing Authorities to limit and/or reduce electric generation demand on our system, to the extent it does not impact electric system integrity.

All SoCalGas storage fields, including Aliso Canyon, are being used to provide system reliability. SoCalGas will post the withdrawal volumes on ENVOY following the conclusion of the withdrawal event.

SoCalGas' Dial it Down Campaign will remain active through the weekend; however, the Smart Therm program cannot be deployed on weekends.

We will continue to provide any material updates as they occur.
