PETITION FOR CHANGE OF OPERATIONAL CONTROL for the Hanford Peaker Plant (01-EP-7C)

On February 1, 2019, MRP San Joaquin Energy, LLC, filed a petition with the California Energy Commission (Energy Commission) requesting to transfer operational control for the Hanford Peaker Plant (HPP) from AltaGas Tracy Operations, Inc., to MRP San Joaquin Energy LLC. The simple-cycle, natural gas-fired, 95-megawatt facility was certified by the Energy Commission in its Decision on April 26, 2001, and began commercial operation on September 3, 2001. The facility is located approximately three miles south of the City of Hanford in Kings County.

The request would transfer responsibility for compliance with conditions of certification to MRP San Joaquin Energy, LLC. A statement describing the change in operational control, signed under penalty of perjury by a representative of MRP San Joaquin Energy, LLC, was submitted as required by Title 20, California Code of Regulations, section 1769(b)(2). The statement affirms that the new owner agrees to be bound by the requirements of the Energy Commission's Decision for the project and understands the obligations imposed by the conditions of certification. The Energy Commission may approve changes of operational control after a 14-day public notice.
