On February 8, 2019 a petition was filed and docketed with the California Energy Commission (Energy Commission) requesting to change operational control of the Midway Peaking Project to NAES Corporation. The 120-megawatt simple cycle electric generating station, certified by the Energy Commission on January 16, 2008, and began operation on May 1, 2009. The facility is located on 5.6 acres in an unincorporated area of western Fresno County, approximately 15 miles southwest of the City of Mendota.

The petition is requesting to change operational control of the facility to NAES Corporation. Energy Commission staff will review the petition, and any comments received during a 14 day public notice period, to determine whether to issue a staff approval under Title 20, California Code of Regulations, section 1769(b)(2).
