Pacific Gas and Electric Company (PG&E) has reviewed the Renewable Portfolio Standard (RPS) Publicly Owned Utilities (POU) Verification Results Draft Reports for Compliance Period 2 (2014-2016) and appreciates the California Energy Commission's (CEC) RPS staff's extensive efforts to conduct the necessary analysis, review and verification of POU claims. While PG&E notes that the majority of POUs met or exceeded the RPS procurement quantity requirement for Compliance Period 2, PG&E is concerned that six POUs failed to meet the target.

These same six entities also failed to meet the RPS procurement requirements in Compliance Period 1 (2011-2013). In applying the RPS requirement to POUs, the intent was for all California load-serving entities to contribute equally to the achievement of this important clean energy goal. The CEC should apply the compliance and enforcement remedies available to it to ensure overall program success.

Thank you for your work on this important topic. PG&E looks forward to the issuance of the final RPS verification reports for Compliance Period 2 and will be sure to give it our attention once it becomes available.
