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## Proposed Tribal Government Challenge

#### Goals:

- Partner with California Native American Tribes
- Support California's climate and renewable energy policies through planning and analysis
- Develop replicable plans or strategies that will help Tribes implement plans or access funding opportunities
- Two Parts to Challenge:
  - Part 1 Tribal Grant Program
  - Part 2 Statewide Gap Analysis



# Part 1 – Proposed Tribal Grant Program

- \$2 million for tribal planning grants
  - **-** \$150,000 **-** \$250,000
- Eligible proposals must be:
  - Planning only
  - Completed within 12-16 months
  - Submitted by California Native American Tribes
- Funds shall target lands:
  - Exclusively within California
  - Tribally owned, under tribal jurisdiction, in trust



#### Planning Activity Examples

Activity	Example
Develop Plan, Policy, or Regulation	<ul> <li>Reduce energy use</li> <li>Increase energy efficiency</li> <li>Reach renewable energy goals</li> </ul>
Prepare Feasibility Studies	<ul> <li>Achieve energy efficiency</li> <li>Develop renewable energy resources</li> <li>Develop electric vehicle infrastructure</li> </ul>
Conduct Energy Audits	<ul> <li>Inform energy efficiency improvements</li> <li>Buildings, facilities, transportation</li> </ul>



#### Part 2 – Proposed Statewide Gap Analysis

- \$250,000 contract for a statewide tribal gap analysis
- Eligible contractor must:
  - Have knowledge of tribal governments, tribal energy needs, and climate change impacts
  - Complete report within 12-16 months
- Analyze tribal impacts and needs regarding energy and climate change and effects on tribal disadvantaged communities.
