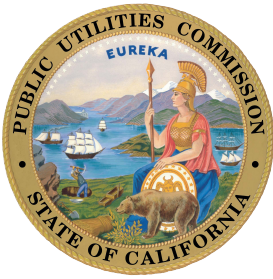

The California Public Utilities Commission (CPUC) and the California Energy Commission (CEC) are seeking applications from interested persons to fill a seat on the Senate Bill 350 Disadvantaged Communities Advisory Group (Advisory Group). ## Instructions for Applicants:

Any person interested in joining the Advisory Group should first review the [SB350 Disadvantaged Advisory Group Charter](#) as well as the web page cited above and then transmit the following materials:

- 1) Resume or curriculum vitae listing or demonstrating his/her significant industry knowledge, subject matter expertise, and experience in a disadvantaged community.
- 2) Letter of interest, not to exceed two pages, that demonstrates his/her qualifications including: (i) his/her ability and willingness to meaningfully participate and provide thoughtful and actionable input, and (ii) how specifically, and perhaps uniquely, he/she hopes to contribute to the Advisory Group. The letter should include the specific geographical location(s) of the disadvantaged community the applicant represents.
- 3) Applicants may also attach letters of support from other parties that describe (i) how the applicant is qualified to serve on the Advisory Group; and (ii) how specifically, and perhaps uniquely, the applicant could contribute to the Advisory Group.
