RE: *2019 Integrated Energy Policy Report (IEPR)*: Request for Extension of Time to File Certain Electricity Demand Forecasts

Dear Ms. Hackney:

This letter is in response to your April 3, 2019, written request to extend the filing deadline for Southern California Edison (SCE) to submit certain Electricity Demand Forecast forms required by the Energy Commission in support of the *2019 Integrated Energy Policy Report (2019 IEPR)*. The Energy Commission adopted detailed instructions describing the scope and timing of these required data submissions at a Business Meeting on November 7, 2018.

SCE is seeking an extension from April 15, 2019 to April 30, 2019, to submit specific portions of Electricity Demand Forecast Form 1.6a to the Energy Commission. According to the request, SCE is currently migrating its load data to a new platform and therefore cannot obtain hourly, historical direct access (DA) and Community Choice Aggregation (CCA) data until late April. SCE plans still to submit Form 1.6a, in part, by the original April 15, 2019 filing deadline, excluding DA and CCA load data. SCE requests an allowance to re-submit Form 1.6a, including all required data fields, by April 30, 2019.

I find that good cause exists for the above-described extension. In accordance with Title 20, California Code of Regulations, section 1342(c), I grant SCE's request for extending the deadline to submit DA and CCA load data required by Electricity Demand Forecast Form 1.6a.
