## **Frank Ramirez considerations for 19-MISC-02**

Good Morning Ms. Karen Douglas and Dr. Thomas Gates. Here are some comments on Docket # 19-MISC-02.

1. Consider the potential for having tribes work on the submission of proposals in a consortium. This is probably not possible at this time, but it could be an item submitted for discussion with California Tribes to explore joint ventures that would maximize the resources available.
2. Consider the potential for linking other technology to renewable energy production that would have a very beneficial impact on the California . For example using Bio-Mass technology to reduce forest waste and then use technology to capture CO2 and inject the CO2 into abandoned gas wells.
3. Consider development of Tribal Work Group that could look at potential for joint project development, other than Consortiums.
