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## **Hydrogen Station site in Undevelopable Land**

Hydrogen station site has been selected based on proximity to the drivers. This criterion often puts the proposed station near residential neighborhood. While convenient for hydrogen driver, such location can draw opposition from others in the neighborhood.

In Los Angeles County, there are several pieces of vast undevelopable land that are surrounded by populated neighborhoods and passed by many drivers on busy freeway. On the intersection of 605 Freeway and 60 Freeway, there are Whittier Narrows Flood Control Basin and Puente Hills Landfill. On the intersection of 101 Freeway and 405 Freeway, there is Sepulveda Flood Control Basin. These locations could be easier to get approval and ideal to serve many hydrogen drivers.
