SUBJECT: Laurelwood Data Center compliance with new Bay Area Air Management District's policy for emergency generators and recent thermal plume data request

COMMENTS:

The applicant's representative, Mr. Jerry Salamy with Jacobs scheduled a call to discuss the recent data requests and the Bay Area Air Management District's (BAAQMD) new policy related to emergency generators. The following are the notes from Energy Commission staff's conversation with Mr. Salamy.

Mr. Salamy said he will be docketing revised emission estimates for operations, either this or next week. Jacobs will also do the thermal plume modeling and analysis for the chiller and building cooling system and include the data and equipment parameters so staff can verify. Mr. Salamy anticipates docketing this plume work next week.

In response to the new BAAQMD policy document titled "Calculating Potential to Emit for Emergency Backup Power Generators," Mr. Salamy said the applicant plans on buying emission reduction credits (ERCs) for NOx. Mr. Salamy said that ERCs are available in the Bay Area.

Mr. Salamy said that with the new potential to emit calculated as required by the new BAAQMD policy, the project will now be subject to federal Title V requirements.
