Dear Mr. Messinger:

On September 12, 2019, the California Energy Commission received an inquiry regarding authorization to construct a platform for rupture disk inspection and maintenance at the HBGS. The proposed activities include construction of a 260' x 24' steel platform to provide permanent maintenance access to the HBGS rupture disc assemblies at HBGS.

Staff has reviewed the proposed activities and determined that the activities are not project change subject to Title 20, California Code of Regulations, section 1769, and therefore do not require approval of a post-certification petition. This is because the proposed activities will not change the project design, operation or performance requirements in the Final Commission Decision.

These activities do require Delegate Chief Building Official (DCBO) oversight for plan review and inspections. The project owner is expected to adhere to all applicable Conditions of Certification in the Final Commission Decision, or as previously amended.

One or more of the above mentioned activities requires DCBO oversight for plan review and inspections. Keith Winstead, Compliance Project Manager, will contact you to discuss the process for obtaining DCBO services. No work can proceed on the above noted activities until a DCBO is assigned.
