NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the California Energy Commission (CEC), as lead agency under California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA), has prepared a proposed Negative Declaration and supporting Initial Study for the proposed *Modification of Regulations Governing the Power Source Disclosure Program* project.

Project Location

The proposed project is a statewide rulemaking proceeding with no physical location.

Project Description

The proposed project consists of modifying existing regulations for the Power Source Disclosure program established under Public Utilities Code section 398.1. et seq. The proposed regulations incorporate new statutory requirements and updates other aspects of the program to facilitate implementation, improve clarity, and align with statutory directive.
