ORDER SHORTENING TIME ON MOTION TO COMPEL, VACATING THE REBUTTAL TESTIMONY DEADLINE, AND SUSPENDING THE PREHEARING CONFERENCE AND EVIDENTIARY HEARING

On October 10, 2019, Intervenor Robert Sarvey (Sarvey) filed a "Motion to Compel Staff to Recognize and Respond to Intervenor Sarvey's Comments and Testimony on the IS/MND and extend the deadline for rebuttal testimony" (Motion). Sarvey requests an immediate response from the Committee as the request is time sensitive.

In general, responses to motions are due within 14 days after the motion is filed.³ However, Applicant responded to the Motion on October 11, 2019.⁴ Staff has not yet responded and, absent a Committee directive ordering otherwise, is not required to do so until October 24, 2019.⁵ Because rebuttal testimony is due October 15, 2019,⁶ the Committee must act swiftly on the Motion.

The Committee therefore **ORDERS** as follows:

- 1. Staff shall file its response, if any, to the Motion no later than 3 p.m. October 15, 2019.
- 2. The October 15, 2019 deadline for all parties to file rebuttal testimony is **VACATED** until further order of the Committee.
- 3. The October 21, 2019 deadline for filing Prehearing Conference Statements, the October 31, 2019 Prehearing Conference, and the November 1, 2019 Evidentiary
