PREHEARING CONFERENCE STATEMENT MECP1 SANTA CLARA 1, LLC

In accordance with the Committee's October 10, 2019 Notice of Prehearing Conference, Evidentiary Hearing, Scheduling Order, and Further Orders¹ ("Notice") and October 17, 2019 Order Denying Sarvey Motion to Compel; Granting Motion to Extend Deadline to File Rebuttal Testimony; and Adopting a Second Revised Schedule² ("Order"), MECP1 Santa Clara 1, LLC ("Applicant") files this Prehearing Conference Statement.

- The subject areas that are complete and ready to proceed to Evidentiary Hearing.
 All subject areas are complete and ready to proceed to Evidentiary Hearing.
- 2. The subject areas upon which any party proposes to introduce testimony in writing rather than through oral testimony.

The Applicant will introduce testimony for all subject areas in writing via prefiled testimony rather than through oral testimony. However, should (1) other parties propose to introduce oral testimony for any other subject areas; or (2) the Committee directs oral testimony for any other subject area, the Applicant's witnesses will introduce testimony through both prefiled written testimony and oral testimony for those subject areas, either in person or telephonically.

3. The subject areas that are not complete and not yet ready to proceed to Evidentiary Hearing and the reasons therefor.

All subject areas are complete and ready to proceed to Evidentiary Hearing.

4. The subject areas that remain disputed and require adjudication, the issues in dispute, and the precise nature of the dispute for each issue.

As between California Energy Commission Staff and the Applicant, there are no disputed subject areas or issues that require adjudication.³

As between Mr. Sarvey (the "Intervenor") and the Applicant, based on a review of the comments/testimony filed by the Intervenor,⁴ the Applicant believes that the subject areas of Air Quality, Greenhouse Gas Emission, and Energy Resources may be disputed. However, those disputes involve either (1) Intervenor's arguments on questions of law, which may be addressed in briefing; or (2) hearsay assertions and lay opinions, which should be accorded no evidentiary weight by the Committee. Further, while Mr. Sarvey has claimed that there are jurisdictional issues relating to the Laurelwood Data Center, this is a purely legal question, and does not involve a factual dispute requiring adjudication at the evidentiary hearing. Given that these disputes do not involve factual matters, testimony for these subject areas can be addressed in writing via prefiled testimony rather than through oral testimony.

5. The identity of each witness the party intends to sponsor at the Evidentiary Hearing, the subject area(s) about which the witness(es) will offer testimony, whether the testimony will be oral or in writing, a brief summary of the testimony to be offered by the witness(es), qualifications of each witness, the time required to present testimony by each witness, and whether the witness seeks to testify telephonically.

The Applicant's prefiled testimony and supporting Exhibits coupled with the Staff's prefiled testimony provide substantial evidence to support approval of the Application for Small Power Plant Exemption. The Applicant's witnesses and the qualifications of each are identified in the Applicant's Opening Testimony and Appendix A thereto (Ex. 132). No further affirmative case is required, and the matter may be decided on the November 1, 2019 hearing record.

If, however, the Committee determines that it has questions for witnesses in any subject area, the Applicant will make those witnesses available for oral testimony at the Evidentiary Hearing. The Applicant also may assert its right to sponsor the oral testimony of witnesses for subject areas to respond to any witness sponsored by the Intervenor.

6. Subject areas upon which the party desires to question the other parties' witness(es), a summary of the scope of the questions (including questions regarding witness qualifications), the issue(s) to which the questions pertain, and the time desired to question each witness.

The Applicant may assert its right to object to the introduction of portions of Intervenor Robert Sarvey's prefiled materials. The *Notice* clearly states that the purpose of the Evidentiary Hearing is "to receive evidence into the formal hearing record from the parties and receive public comment." (TN# 230108.) As explained in Section 1212(c)(2) of the Commission's Regulations, "...evidence does not include, among other things, speculation, *argument*, conjecture, and *unsupported* conclusions or opinions." The majority of the Intervenor's Opening Testimony provides legal argument, hearsay, and unsupported lay opinions, not evidence.

7. A list identifying exhibits with transaction numbers (TN) that the party intends to offer into evidence during the Evidentiary Hearing and the technical subject areas to which they apply.

The Applicant's Exhibit List is provided as Attachment A to this *Prehearing Conference Statement*. The Exhibits are also identified by subject matter in Section I.C. of each section of the Applicant's prefiled testimony.

8. Proposals for briefing deadlines or other scheduling matters.

The Applicant does not propose any briefing for this matter. However, to the extent that the Committee determines that briefing of any issues is required, the Applicant proposes the following deadlines:

- Identification by the Committee of any legal or other issues requiring briefing either at the Evidentiary Hearing or by November 6, 2019;
- Submission of optional opening briefs seven (7) days after the docketing of the Evidentiary Hearing transcript.
- Submission of optional reply briefs, if ordered, seven (7) days after the filing of opening briefs.

The Applicant requests that the Evidentiary Hearing transcript be expedited to be docketed on or before November 6, 2019 to facilitate briefing, if ordered, in time for the Committee to issue its Proposed Decision in November 2019.

9. Any objection by the party to the use of the informal hearing procedures outlined in the *Notice*.

In describing the "Informal Hearing Procedures," the Committee's *Notice* describes the parties' witnesses colloquially as "experts." However, the hearing process cannot assume that a panelist is necessarily an expert. Accordingly, the Applicant may assert its right to object to the characterization of all witnesses who may testify on a panel as an "expert" and to cross-examine any witnesses sponsored by the Intervenor.

While noting its desire to accommodate the Committee's preferences, the Applicant objects to the use of informal hearing procedures if the Applicant is not afforded the opportunity to perform direct examination and cross examination before each panel is excused. While some may favor a more free-flowing process, it is imperative that the Applicant, who bears the burden of proof, be afforded the opportunity to create a hearing record. Strict adherence to an informal process can create a disjointed and opaque hearing record, absent the opportunity for clarification of statements, opinions, and assertions.

Some questions demand a clear "Yes" or "No" answer, something the free-form panel discussion may not produce. Cross talk, interruptions, overly-aggressive panel participation, and the fact that sometimes the loudest voice is heard the most can lead to a muddled record. The opportunities for confusion and misdirection are amplified if Intervenor Sarvey is allowed to act as his own witness. Such dual roles for a single person create among other things, ambiguity as

to whether Mr. Sarvey's statements in the transcript are questions for other panelists (which are not evidence), or the testimony of a lay witness. The Applicant should not be placed in the dilemma of having to judge whether certain transcript passages are questions or answers.

In summary, the Applicant will not object to the informal process so long as the Applicant is afforded the opportunity for direct and cross examinations before the close of each panel.
